Claiming Canada Day Statutory Holiday Pay

If you are a 10 month PERMANENT employee filing for Employment Insurance at the end of June, it is important to claim that you will be receiving Statutory Holiday Pay for July 1. This is done by entering the information on the ***'Other Monies Information'*** Screen (Online Applications). Follow the prompts on any drop down menus that appear. Please note the last day worked is June 29, 2018.
