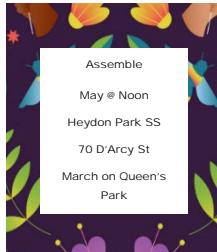
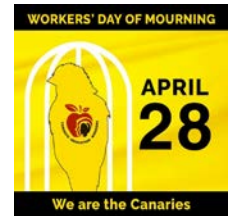
NATIONAL DAY OF MOURNING
